As a pioneer worker, pastor, evangelist and Bible teacher he has made his mark. 17 years ago all responsibilities of the work in Belgium were transferred to their co-workers. Since that time Hans and Marijke Koornstra have given their valuable time to give seminars and hold evangelistic crusades around the world.
