The enemy consistently bombards us with terrorist threats and acts...9/11 – financial 'crashes', Covid, the war in Kuwait, the war in Israel, and more...regardless of those hateful attempts to 'shake us' and overwhelm us, God is on the throne and He changes not.

## SEVEN UNCHANGEABLE TRUTHS

• We have an immovable root.

A man will not be established by wickedness, but the root of the righteous will not be moved. Proverb 12:3 NASB

- We have an everlasting foundation.
- <sup>24</sup> What the wicked fears will come upon him, but the desire of the righteous will be granted. <sup>25</sup> When the whirlwind passes, the wicked is no more, but the righteous has an everlasting foundation. Proverbs 10:24-25 NASB
  - We have an unshakeable kingdom.

<sup>25</sup> See to it that you do not refuse Him who is speaking. For if those did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape who turn away from Him who warns from heaven. <sup>26</sup> And His voice shook the earth then, but now He has promised, saying, "YET ONCE MORE I WILL SHAKE NOT ONLY THE EARTH, BUT ALSO THE HEAVEN." <sup>27</sup> This expression, "Yet once more," denotes the removing of those things which can be shaken, as of created things, so that those things which cannot be shaken may remain. <sup>28</sup> Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe; <sup>29</sup> for our God is a consuming fire. Hebrews 12:25-29 NASB

God is the one who justifies; <sup>34</sup> who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us. <sup>35</sup> Who will separate us from the love of [m] Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? <sup>36</sup> Just as it is written,

"FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED."

<sup>37</sup> But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. <sup>38</sup> For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup> nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
