• This is a year to focus on the Lord and to be faithful to His purposes and my destiny.

- An altar of 'earth'...not stone...make burnt offerings and peace offerings.
- It is about the worship, not the altar.

12 Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. ² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. Romans 12:1-2 NASB

- The burnt offering is a 'sell-out' commitment to the Lord.
- The peace offering is about the wholeness of being right with God.
- Being in right relationship with God and the peace, the wholeness that He places in the heart of man...
- He tells us to make an altar of earth (an everyday altar) so we can have an active everyday connection with God.
